New Leadership Era Begins At WIBC

As Joyce Deitch Take Reins

Joyce Deitch of Las Vegas was elected the seventh President in WIBC history by the 3483 delegates attending WIBC's 76th Annual Meeting at Baton Rouge.

Deitch, who is WIBC's first vice president, will president, will assume her threeyear presidential term August 1. She succeeds retiring President Gladys M. Banker of W. Virginia.

"What do you about being sav elected Prsident of the largest women's sports organization in the world? Deitch said. "You can wrap some prety wonderful thoughts around words like commitment, and report on your vision for future .. "

... "Together we can refine our goals and refocus our objectives to adapt to the needs of today's women,"

"You said Deitch. have proven right to lead WIBC, and our pocus is stated in words we said here. WIBC is dynamic women handin-hand, united in common cause. We'll face the future with courage, faith and integrity together."

Deitch was the sole candidate nominated by the WIBC Nominating Committee for the office of WIBC President.

Increase year's This most hotly debate4d legislation was a proposed amendment increase WIBC to national dues from \$2.75 to \$6. Numer ous delegates spoke both for and against the increase with floor discussion lasting 57 minutes. Two alternative amendments were proposed and defeated. One would have raised WIBC dues by \$1 and would other

have raised dues by \$2.50.

Amendments In other leg action. islative delegates followed the recommendaton of the WIBC Board of Directors approving 19, de feating 12, no considering one and withdrawing one of 33 proposed amend ments.

One amendment changed bylaws to allow not only U.S. cities to host the WIBC Championship Tournament but Canadian cities as well. Another adds a new membership classification International filiate Membership. a spec ial for ladies who are not serviced by certified associations. Cost of IAM will be \$50 and carries all the privileges of regular membership.

Under one ado pted amendment WIBC will be allowed to create a national membership database

to prov ide direct communication to members and determine

needs.
