mourn loss of local writer

Joe Vito Buenrostro was featured with a picture in Ella O'Quinn's first edition of the San Antonio Kegler in June of 1976 and her final publication last week.

O'Quinn, 65, a nationally known writer, publicist, administrator and supporter in the bowling industry, died Sunday morning at home.

"Her death will leave a void in any local or area bowling tournament," Buenrostro said. "She was always there. She played a big part in my being inducted into the local and state Halls of Fame."

People who knew the six-time

Texas Women's Writer of the Year and local Hall of Fame member were shocked.

"It's unbelievable," said Mary Falconer, an eight time local Superior Performance Award winner. "Ella was a special lady. They don't make any more like her. She took time with every one and made them feel like they were special. She blessed so many people she touched."

Funeral services for O'Quinn will be held at 1 p.m. Wednesday at the Porter Loring Funeral Chapel. A room will be open for mourners after 5 p.m. Tuesday. Burial is at Chapel Hill Cemetery.



Ella O'Quinn published the bowling weekly The Kegler for more than 18 years.

"It's a stunner," said PBA national tour director Johnny Campos at the pros' tournament stop in Rochester, N.Y. "She was like a second mother to me, and a mother to the about a second mother to me, and a mother to all boulers in San Antonia".

"Ella was a longtime friend of
the PBA, both personally and pro-

fessionally," said Kevin Shippy, the PBA's director of public relations. "She was instrumental in getting the city behind us when we were in San Antonio."

"I remember that she supported the Lady Pro Bowlers Tour as well as the PBA's event," said LPBT commissioner John Falzone from Rockford, Ill. "Obviously, the bowling community is going to miss her."

Among O'Quinn's bowling achievements was earning the Wood Award for excellence in promotion of bowling through journalism. She was named member emeritus of the Texas 600 Club in 1987 and served in every capacity

in the San Antonio Women's Bowling Association, including president

dent.
"Ella lived for the game and loved the people who participated in bowling," said Lil Poole of Hurst, a TWBA Hall of Famer and former state secretary. "She was a talented person who had a way with words. She could put them on paper in such a beautiful fashion. She was a fixture in the game for more than 35 years, at least."

"There aren't any words to describe Ella," said Bob Martin, the local SABA secretary. "She can't be replaced. It was like a bowling ball, just part that isn't going to be there any

more."

"Ella was one of the pioneers in bowling." said Betty Holzmann, the president of SAWBA. "She had so many years invested in the game. Whenever you needed any thing, you could count on Ella. It's simple — when you thought of bowling, you thought of Ella."

"Whether you agreed with Ella or not she always commanded respect," said Sylvia Broyles, a WIBC vice-president and current TWBA secretary. "She gave her time in what she believed."

O'Quinn is survived by her husband, Karl; two daughters, Kathy and Karen; and her mother, Ella Woodbury.




