## GREATER SAN ANTONIO USBC WOMEN'S TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament shall be governed by the provisions of Chapter 6 of the USBC Playing Rules pertaining to Local Championship Tournament.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** Entry will be open to current female members of the Greater San Antonio USBC.
3. **TOURNAMENT AVERAGES:**
  - A. Entrants will use their highest 2021-2022 USBC certified league average of 21 or more games taken from BOWL.COM. Entering average is subject to change if participant bowled in any league which did not submit averages, provided the final average sheet is on file in the Greater San Antonio USBC office prior to the distribution of prizes.
  - B. If no previous season average, an entrant shall use her highest GSAUSBC certified league average as of the end of the previous summer season, provided she has bowled 21 or more games.
  - C. If no previous winter or summer league average has been established, an entrant shall use her highest current GSAUSBC certified league average of twelve (12) games or more on closing date of entry (Tuesday, October 25, 2022).
  - D. Entrants not having an average as specified above will use their highest GSAUSBC certified league average of twelve (12) or more games on date of participation.
  - E. All others bowl with a 220 average.
  - F. Rule 319A - Item #2 - Does not apply to this tournament.
4. Entry closing date shall be October 25, 2022. All entries must be submitted in writing to the Association Manager on approved entry blanks with correct fees. The schedule for Team and/or individuals as assigned by the Tournament Committee will be considered accepted unless refused within five (5) days of the postmarked confirmation. After such time, no refunds of entry fees may be made. All entries postmarked the first Post Office business day following the closing date shall be accepted. **Reservations will be accepted but entry fees must be paid by October 18, 2022 or lanes will be released.**
5. **HANDICAP:** The Tournament shall be handicapped. There shall be TWO DIVISIONS. The handicap shall be 90% from the following scratch figures: TEAM EVENT FROM 880 and SINGLES FROM 220.
6. **TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONS:**
  - A. The scratch score winners in each event shall be the CHAMPIONS, and highest All-Events scratch score winner, regardless of her Division, shall be declared the CITY CHAMPION.
  - B. The handicap score winners in each event shall be the LOCAL HANDICAP CHAMPIONS, and the highest All-Events handicap score winner, regardless of her Division, shall be declared the LOCAL HANDICAP CHAMPION. The handicap shall be based on 90% of the difference of 220.
7. **TEAM EVENT:** A member may bowl as often as she wishes in Team event; however, no more than two players may bowl together more than once.
8. **SINGLES EVENT:** A member may bowl only one singles event.
9. **ALL EVENTS:** Only those paying the optional fee shall be eligible for prize money in ALL EVENTS. Paid ALL EVENTS are not transferable unless substitute replaces original entrant in two events and the transfer is made by the Tournament Manager prior to the substitute's participation in any event. The first Team score shall count for ALL EVENTS. ALL EVENTS ARE TEAM & SINGLES SCORES.
10. Participants should check in thirty (30) minutes before scheduled time of event. Substitutions should be reported at check-in.
11. The prize list of winners will be posted in all local bowling establishments within ten (10) days after the close of the Tournament. ONE WEEK will be allowed for protest of the winner's prize list. After that time the prizes will be paid according the posted list.
